DESCRIPTION OF MISSIONS

1. Deployment of HSE policy
 - Lead and unite a network of relay actors (service managers)
 - Working with other company stakeholders in HSE matters (intervention in the CSE)
2. HSE project management and operational monitoring
 - Ensure the drafting and updating of mandatory documents (Single File, Document Relating to Protection Against Explosions, annual prevention program and HSE activity report, etc.)
 - Implement a continuous improvement methodology and processes within the existing organization to comply with regulatory requirements
 - Manage the HSE part of the Quality Management System: Write the procedures, instructions and forms used by employees
 - Organize field audits based on internal or external benchmarks
 - Implement action plans when HSE objectives are not met
 - Manage the planning and interventions of control bodies (professional exposure limit value, etc.), prevention (training, etc.), certification or specialized advice
 - Carry out studies to assess and anticipate professional and environmental risks, and make

proposals for improvement actions

- Raise awareness, train or have operational teams trained in compliance with safety procedures (wearing PPE, etc.)
- Use and update the SEIRICH (INRS) database for the management of chemical products
- Be a pilot of the SST (Workplace First Aid) volunteer group
